Endorsement of Non-Federally Authored Geospatial Standards

- Steering Committee established in November 2005 the:
 - FGDC Policy on Recognition of Non-Federally Authored Geographic Information Standards and Specifications
- Mechanism for FGDC recognition of non-Federally authored standards or specifications that are relevant to the missions and spatial data responsibilities of Federal agencies as set forth in OMB Circular A-16.
- The following action exercises that policy and CG input has been solicited to prepare a recommendation to the Steering Committee.

- NGA requested FGDC endorse DISA approved standards (sent 5/10 to CG)
- List has been expanded to 66 voluntary consensus, de facto, and other standards
- Standards WG recommended a review and concurrence process with a condensed timeline
 - Standards have been through their standard organization's review and vetting process
 - Endorsement process is not requesting comments on the actual content of a standard but on its suitability to be an FGDC endorsed standard



- At its July 7, 2010 meeting the Standards WG developed a list of external standards for recommendation
- Includes 66 voluntary consensus, de facto and other standards:
 - Identified by FGDC member agencies
 - Approved by the Geospatial Intelligence Standards Working Group (GWG) for inclusion in the DoD IT Standards and Profile Registry (DISR)
 - Relevant to the Federal Civil community
 - Relevant to the initial implementation of the Geospatial Platform and Roadmap time box 1 deliverables
 - "Adopt and enforce open and interoperable standards to leverage the work already accomplished by national and international standards organizations."



- Predominantly OGC standards and American National Standards, including ISO standards that are adopted/to be adopted as U.S. National Standards (i.e. no ISO standards the US does not support)
- List includes voluntary consensus standards developed through:
 - ISO, the International Organization for Standardization standards
 - INCITS, the InterNational Committee for Information Technology Standards, a standards development organization accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI)
 - OGC, the Open Geospatial Consortium



Process

- CG members to have their agencies review the list of standards recommended for endorsement
- Document in the supplied spreadsheet the recommendation for each standard, i.e.: endorse, defer endorsement, do not endorse
- For defer endorsement and do not endorse standards:
 - Provide a detailed reason why the identified standards should be deferred or not be endorsed
 - Provide the steps your agency will take, or would like see taken before endorsement can occur



Process and Timeline

- CG members to send in their agency's recommendations by Wednesday, August 11 – call has already gone out
- The Standards WG chair will use the responses to create a recommendation report. This will be reviewed by the Standards WG for concurrence by August 27
- Final Standards WG recommendation will be sent to the CG for a 14-calendar day review and concurrence period, ending September 14.
- FGDC OS will compile the results into a final recommendation for electronic vote/endorsement by the SC, ending September 27 (13 days).
- The FGDC OS will compile the SC responses into a report of record, and notify the FGDC committees of the final outcome by September 30.



- ◆ ACTION: Coordination Group review and recommendation for endorsement of geospatial standards as guided by the FGDC Policy on Recognition of Non-Federally Authored Geographic Information Standards and Specifications and provide input for a consolidated recommendation to the Steering Committee.
