Introduction

Federal Geographic Data Committee

- The Purpose of the Cultural and Demographic Statistics Subcommittee is to promote the collections, use, sharing, and dissemination of cultural and demographic geospatially referenced data pertinent to the needs of the Nation.
- The Subcommittee has not met since June of 2008.
- Past projects include:
 - United States Thoroughfare, Landmark, and Postal Address Data Standard – approved in 2011
 - Cultural Resource Standard being developed through the Cultural Resource Working Group headed by the National Park Service



Proposal

- ◆ The Chair of this Subcommittee would like to propose the discontinuation of the Cultural and Demographic Statistics Subcommittee due to the elimination of the A-16 Theme by the same name.
- The only current project, the Cultural Resource Standard, would be more suitable under the new Cultural Resource Theme. We are working with the NPS to determine the best approach to this issue.
